What is a CoC?!

Our local CoCs ("Continuum of Care") administer and coordinate housing and homeless services programs funded by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"). In Western Massachusetts, the Berkshire/Franklin/Hampshire ("3 County") CoC and the Hampden County CoC administer more than \$3M per year in support of transitional and permanent housing programs operated by 16 different organizations.
