Accelerate Housing Placements

Expand Access to Affordable Units

1. Create CoC housing locator position
2. Identify flex funds for housing pipeline
3. Implement FOH 769 move-on strategy

Coordinate Services & Efficient Processes

1. Incorporate SHA into coordinated entry
2. Begin housing search at housing referral
3. Allow CES to decide CC RRH eligibility

Prevent Chronic Homeless

Build an At-Risk List & Data Infrastructure

1. Develop at-risk CH list in Homelink
2. Review data re who ages into CH

Target & Develop Housing Interventions

1. Adjust CC RRH program to serve at risk
2. Identify housing resources for at risk
3. Use alt case conferencing for at risk
